Violations of this rule shall be dealt with in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

By entering this Trial each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the Trial and agrees to release and save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the Trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that

this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.

Please Note: New CKC Ruling: Canadian Resident non CKC Members Running a wholly owned Dog Cannot win a placement unless they pay a Non Member Participation Fee or a Membership Fee to The CKC.

Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn.

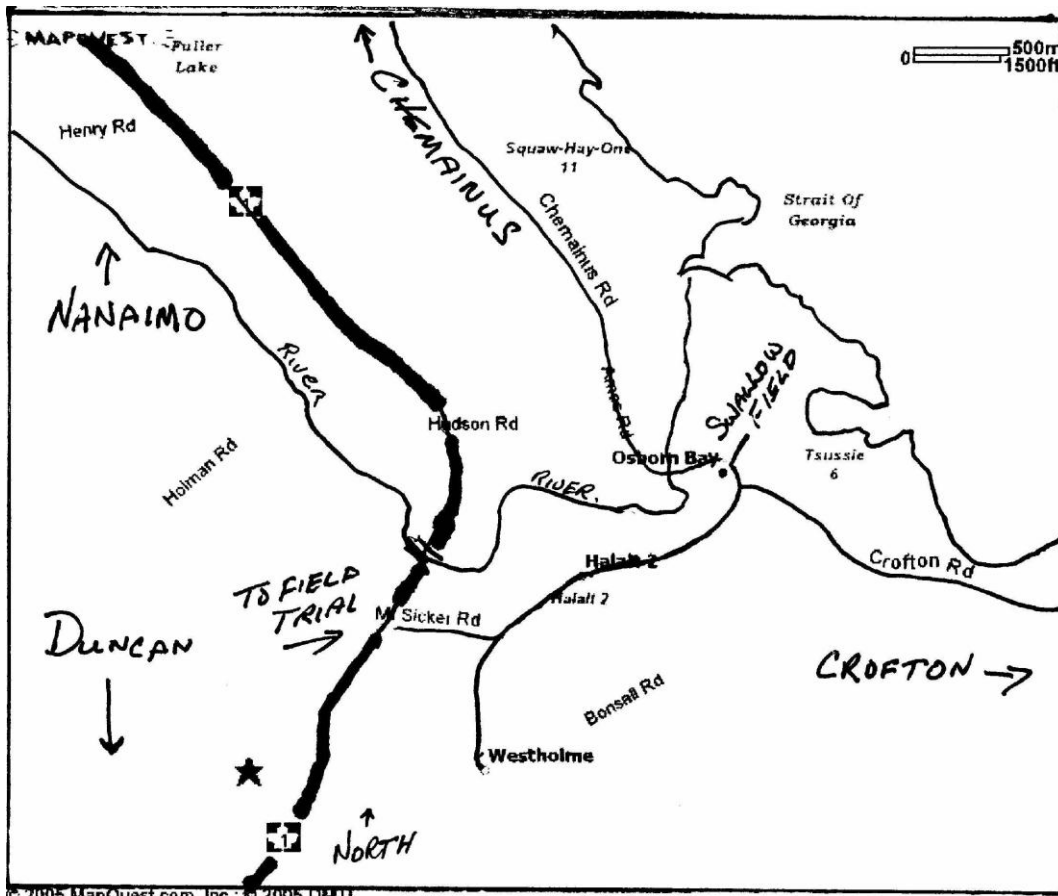
REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death. Other refunds (less a scratch fee of \$10.00 per dog) may be given for good cause at the discretion of the field trial committee. All requests for refunds must be in writing and must be received within 2 days of the last day of the trial and, unless otherwise agreed by the field trial committee, must be accompanied by a Veterinarian's certificate

Males and Females will be run in the order of the draw. Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of its time to run may be disqualified. **Starting Dog in the Open Stakes to be determined by the TSX closing on Thursday April 19, 2012**

Dead Ducks will be used in all stakes.
Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded.
